Anna lectures internationally on all aspects of exotic animal and wildlife medicine and has published widely in this field. She is an author and co-editor of the BSAVA Manual of Exotic Pets, Manual of Rabbit Medicine and Surgery and Manual of Rodents and Ferrets.
