Join us and make your voice heard.

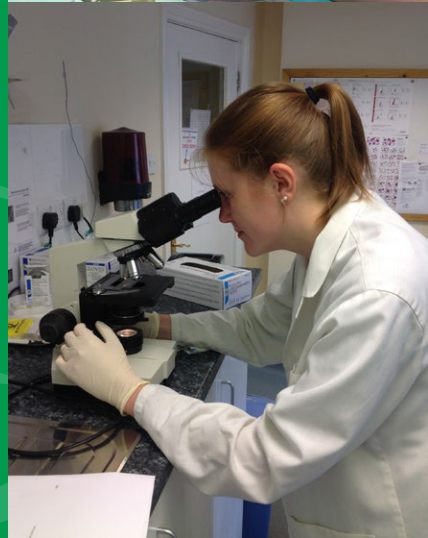
BVNA is owned by its members and exists to promote animal health and welfare through the ongoing development of professional excellence in veterinary nursing.

CATEGORIES OF MEMBERSHIP



A FULL MEMBER

New joining fee £52.00
Subsequent years fee £46.00

This category is for Registered Veterinary Nurses with the RCVS.

B STUDENT MEMBER

New joining fee £33.00
Subsequent years fee £28.00

This category is for student veterinary nurses currently enrolled on a veterinary nursing qualification, enrolled students on the ANA and VCA courses.

Applications for student membership must be submitted with an awarding body enrolment number.

C ASSOCIATE MEMBER

New joining fee £41.50
Subsequent years fee £37.50

This category is for persons working in practice or associated fields, but who are not Registered Veterinary Nurses. Associate membership includes qualified ANAVCAs, receptionists and supporters of the Association and its activities.

The following discount scheme is available to all employers paying their staff's membership fee and has the number of employees as current members of BVNA:

5 EMPLOYEES or more

10% discount

10 EMPLOYEES or more

12% discount

15 EMPLOYEES or more

15% discount

To be eligible for the discount the membership payment must be made directly by the employer.

The 'subsequent years' annual rate is only applicable if you renew within two months of your membership expiry date.

For European subscribers (outside the UK) please add £4 and for those from the rest of the world add £10 to the rates above.
