



Oral Care Nurse Course Terms and Conditions 2020 (updated March 2020)

1. The course is open to Registered Veterinary Nurses (RVNs). Applicants from outside the UK will need to provide evidence of qualifications and registration within the relevant country.
2. The course is £10 to members of the BVNA and BVDA. There is a cost of £30 for non-members.
3. Candidates must complete all sections of the course by the course end date of midnight on 31st July (British Summer Time).
4. Candidates must achieve a minimum of 70 per cent to achieve the certificate and badge, and have a maximum of three attempts at completing the final multiple-choice question assessment.
5. Candidates achieving 80 per cent or more with a maximum of three attempts at the final multiple-choice question assessment will be invited to provide their contact details for a chance to attend a bonus CPD day at Waltham.
6. There is a maximum of 50 places available per day at the Waltham Centre. These will be held on Wednesday 23rd and Thursday 24th September 2020.
7. If more than 100 RVNs successfully achieve 80 per cent or more with a maximum of three attempts and provide their contact details for a chance to attend the bonus CPD day at Waltham, delegates will be selected at random.
8. Those successfully receiving a place will be allocated one of the bonus days and be notified by 10th August. They will be expected to confirm their attendance by 4pm on 21st August 2020.
9. Allocated days are not transferable to another date or to another candidate of the delegate's choice.
10. Failure to respond by the deadline date will result in the forfeit and re-allocation of the place.
11. Candidates that confirm attendance at one of the Waltham days and fail to attend could be liable for a non-attendance fee of £30.
12. BVNA, BVDA and Waltham will not contribute to any travel expenses or accommodation requirements, with candidates acknowledging this is their own responsibility.
13. Certificates and badges will be sent out on a monthly basis to those who complete the course in the previous month.

14. Pedigree & Whiskas Oral Care Clinic kits are only available for UK practices whilst stocks last. One kit will be provided to each practice even if there is more than one RVN from the practice registered on the course.
15. These terms and conditions only apply to the cohort of RVNs taking the course commencing on 2nd March 2020. It does not apply to any other course or cohort.
